



**Position:** Server

**Reports to:** General Manager

**Position Information:** Server is responsible for food and beverage service including greeting guests, making suggestions for orders based on customer's taste, providing education about our products, taking orders, food and beverage delivery to tables, clearing the appropriate meal courses, cashing out guest's checks, and cleaning tables for next seating if and when needed. The employee will be responsible for maintaining positive guest relations throughout the guests' experience.

**Duties and Responsibilities:**

- Responsible for delivering orders to the guest's table in the dining room/bar area
- Responsible for welcoming and interacting with guests in a positive and friendly manner
- If and when needed, responsible for bussing tables, disposing of trash, maintaining the cleanliness of all restaurant areas, transporting dirty dishes to the washing area
- As part of the team to ensure that the overall cleanliness of the dining/bar areas are maintained throughout the hours of operation.

**Qualifications:**

- Excellent communication skills (must effectively convey information)
- Ability to read, understand and follow instruction
- Flexibility to handle multiple tasks and keep multiple jobs running and organized
- Previous dining/table service experience required
- Full availability for any shift, five (5) days per week, including nights, weekends, and holidays
- Required high school diploma or equivalency
- Experience with POS required
- Have a fundamental knowledge and love of craft beer
- Must be able to handle weights up to 30 lbs
- Must be able to safely climb stairs various times during shift with food tray, bussing bin and/or drinks
- Must be able to handle weights up to 150 lbs. with assistance
